WHAT CAN YOU DO IF THERE'S A CIVIL DEFENCE EMERGENCY?

- ▶ Listen to your local radio station (listed here) and follow advice and instructions
- ▶ Activate your predetermined telephone tree to warn others
- ▶ Prepare to activate your household emergency plan (there's a copy on www.hunua.org.nz or www.getthru.govt.nz)
- ▶ If you have access, visit www.hunua.org.nz

All instructions given by Emergency Services or the Civil Defence Controller must be followed.

IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO EVACUATE:

- ▶ Listen to the radio and follow instructions
- ▶ Take your getaway kit and essential items with you.
- ▶ Consider the care of your pets and livestock.
- ▶ Follow instructions provided by your Emergency Response Group, Emergency Services, and Civil Defence

WHERE IS YOUR EVACUATION CENTRE?

HUNUA: Hunua School

ARARIMU: Ararimu School **OR** Ararimu Hall: crnr Steel Road and Ararimu Road

PAPARIMU: Paparimu School **OR** Paparimu Hall: 345 Paparimu Road



WHAT IS A NEIGHBOURHOOD RESPONSE PLAN?

This is the plan that is activated through the Emergency Response Group, in the event of an emergency or natural disaster that affects Hunua, Ararimu and/or Paparimu.

WHAT'S THE OBJECTIVE OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD RESPONSE PLAN?

To use local resources to sustain our communities until outside emergency service agencies are able to respond. This could take hours, or days.

WHO IS THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE GROUP (ERG)?

Your ERG is made up of people from your community who have worked with Auckland Civil Defence to develop a Neighbourhood Response Plan for our three valleys.

The ERG liaise with emergency services and civil defence to initiate and assist in response to a civil defence emergency (flooding, volcanic ash or earthquake for example.)

WHAT CAN YOU DO NOW?



If you haven't already done so, please advise a member of the Emergency Response Group listed on the back:

- ▶ If you may need assistance in the event that an evacuation is required
- ▶ If you have a skill or resource which may be of use during an emergency situation



If you haven't already, set up an emergency survival kit (there's a list on the Get Ready Get Thru guide).



Make sure you have a household emergency plan - from www.hunua.org.nz or www.getthru.govt.nz



Ensure you have an emergency plan for domestic animals (pets) and livestock.
